<u>Italian Language Immersion Trip</u> (Open to students Grades 9-12 enrolled in Italian. One year of language proficiency required. *Minimum 12 students* required to run the trip.)

Ursuline students and faculty chaperones will travel to Florence, Italy, the Cradle of the Renaissance, for an exciting trip built around conversing in the Italian Language. Students will attend three mornings of Italian language classes taught by native professors at the Leonardo da Vinci School located in the historical center of Florence. Students will spend their afternoons practicing Italian, seeing world renowned artwork in the Galleria d'Uffizi, visiting Il Duomo and walking along Ponte Vecchio. The group will take an authentic Tuscan cooking class and weather permitting, also enjoy a unique bike ride around the medieval walls of Lucca. Another highlight of this global journey to Italy will be an excursion to the beautiful, medieval towns of Siena and San Gimignano.

The students will have three mornings of language classes in Barcelona with a native Spanish instructor. This exciting science research trip will be action-packed with sea turtle monitoring and mammal-tracking field research, lessons on sea turtle biology and ecology, exploration and restoration of mangrove ecosystems, and discussion about conservation issues affecting the area. This trip will include 20 hours of fieldwork and 20 hours of science coursework, culture and language immersion. Another amazing opportunity will be a one-day visit with local high school students.

Ursuline students and faculty chaperones will take a historical and cultural journey to Athens and Thessaloniki, Greece during Easter break 2020. The goal of this trip is to enhance students' understanding of Greek and Roman religion, ritual, art and history through on-site lectures and gallery talks and by visiting the most famous museums and archeological sites in Greece. Highlights will include: the Akropolis and Agora in Athens, the Byzantine churches of Thessaloniki, Pella (Alexander the Great's hometown), the tombs at Mycenae and Vergina, and the sonically perfect Greek theater at the massive site of Epidauros.
